CASE STUDY #03

RUSTIC FUNCTIONALITY MEETS OLD-WORLD CHARM

Faced with the task of storing masses of beautiful fragile porcelain from far corners of the world, Jane Visser and Mark Thomas decided that an elegantly tall storage dresser should become the feature of this farmhouse kitchen. A very large central island was placed between the kitchen and the living room, and this functions as a sociable tasting area for the owners – who are passionate about wine – and as a work surface. This island is slightly higher than usual to suit one of the owners, who is very tall; another countertop is at a conventional height and that beside the stove is lower than average – these provide a range of heights to suit all activities. The detailed joinery

design is by Janetta Lehmensich of Visser & Thomas Architects. Contemporary details such as the choice of suspended lighting work well with the historical style of the house but also balance the collection of rugs and well-thumbed recipe books.
